Kang confident of Malaysian defence

Defending champion Anthony Kang of the United States is ready to face the challenges of a strong international field in the 49th edition of the Maybank Malaysian Open, with KJ Choi, Daniel Chopra, Darren Clarke, Thongchai Jaidee and Shingo Katayama among the headline names in Kuala Lumpur.

Kang's win last season earned him full playing rights on the European Tour and he believes his experiences of The Race to Dubai have made him a better player ahead of his title defence at the refurbished Kuala Lumpur Golf and Country Club.

"I've learnt a lot from playing in Europe and I'm beginning to see the positive signs," said Kang. "My game is better than last year so I'm really excited. It's always exciting going back to Malaysia.

"But this time we're going to a

different course so it will be a slightly different feeling to my title defence in that respect.

"The positive aspect to that is that I don't really feel much pressure going back as the defending champion. Hopefully I can win and open more doors again."

Of the headline names, Jaidee will be among the favourites to win given his recent form and history at the event.

Jaidee, Asia's Number One, has won the Maybank Malaysian Open twice and has been in

great early season form on the European Tour, finishing third in the Dubai Desert Classic and then reaching the quarter finals of the WGC - Accenture Match Play, where he lost to eventual winner Ian Poulter.

Jaidee is currently ninth in The Race to Dubai and will be expecting to put in a strong performance on familiar territory.

"I have won this tournament twice and it would be great if I could come back and win the title again," he said.

"We always have a good time

here and it will be even better if I can put in a good showing."

Like Jaidee, Clarke is also close to winning form having begun his season brightly.

The Northern Irishman has registered two top ten finishes already this year, and could be a force to be reckoned with.

India's Arjun Atwal, another double Maybank Malaysian Open champion having won the event in 2003 and 2008, will be another possible contender as he looks to complete a hat-trick of victories on Malaysian soil.

He has won three times on the European Tour, and was also Asia's Number One in 2003.

"I obviously like the event as I've always done well in Malaysia. I've won twice and it's a good tournament for me," said Atwal.

DID YOU KNOW?

- The Maybank Malaysian Open became part of The European Tour International Schedule in 1999, and was the first co-sanctioned event between The European and Asian Tours. It was played at the Saujana Golf and Country Club, and won by American Gerry Norquist. The 2010 edition will be the 61st tournament jointly held between the two Tours.
- Anthony Kang will be aiming to make a successful defence of his crown he claimed 12 months ago. In 2009, his success was made all the more remarkable after an opening two over par 74 - the highest opening round by a winner of the 2009 European Tour season.
- Thongchai Jaidee will be trying to continue his wonderful form in the event. He was victorious in 2004 and 2005, second in 2006 (the last time the event was staged at the Kuala Lumpur Golf & Country Club), and tied seventh in 2001.
- Since 1999, six of the 11 tournaments have been won by players claiming their maiden European Tour International Schedule victory. They are: Gerry Norquist (1999), Yeh Wei-tze (2000), Alastair Forsyth (2002), Thongchai Jaidee (2004), Charlie Wi (2006) and Anthony Kang (2009).

DRIVING ACCURACY

Defined as both an average number of fairways per round and a percentage of fairways hit.

DRIVING DISTANCE

Defined as an average number of yards per drive. Two drives are measured per round on holes chosen to counteract the effect of gradient or wind. The drives are measured at the point they come to rest regardless of whether they are on the fairway or not.

GREENS IN REGULATION

Defined as both an average number of greens per round and a percentage of greens hit. A green in regulation is defined as the number of shots that a player should take to reach the putting surface on any given hole, being one for Par 3s, two for Par 4s and three for Par 5s.

PUTTS PER GIR

Defined as both the average number of putts taken per green in regulation and the average number of putts taken per round on greens that are hit in regulation. By doubling the greens per round figure and thereby assuming two putts on each green in regulation, we can then subtract the GIR putts per round figure from this total to infer the number of strokes under par the player will be per round from the greens hit in regulation.

AVERAGE PUTTS

Defined as the average number of putts taken per round. The use of the putter from off the green does not constitute a putt as far as the statistics are concerned.

The United States Ryder Cup Team Qualification for The 2010 Ryder Cup

Qualification for the United States Team began with the four Major Championships contested in 2009, and will continue from January 1, 2010 until August 15, 2010. The top eight players will automatically qualify for the 2010 United States Ryder Cup Team, with the remaining four places reserved for Captain's picks.

The selection process will be determined by the following criteria:

1. Prize money earned in the 2009 Masters Tournament, US Open, Open Championship and US PGA Championship - one point for every US\$1,000 earned.
2. Prize money earned in Official Events in 2010 from January 1 until August 15 - one point for every US\$1,000 earned, excluding Major Championships and events played in the same weeks as Major Championships and World Golf Championships.
3. Prize money earned in the 2010 Major Championships - two points for every US\$1,000 earned.
4. Prize money earned in 2010 events played in the same weeks as Major Championships and opposite World Golf Championships between January 1 until August 15 - half a point for every US\$1,000 earned.

The European Ryder Cup Team Qualification for The 2010 Ryder Cup

The European Team will be selected employing the following criteria:

(a) The leading four players on The Ryder Cup World Points List (1) as of Sunday, August 29, 2010, or at the conclusion of the Johnnie Walker Championship at Gleneagles, whichever is the latter. In the event of a tie (equal number of points accumulated), placings will be decided by the player with the higher ranking on the Official World Golf Ranking as of Monday, August 23, 2010.

(b) The leading five players, not otherwise qualified (having selected the four players from The Ryder Cup World Points List) from The Ryder Cup European Points List (2) as of Sunday, August 29, 2010, or at the conclusion of the Johnnie Walker Championship at Gleneagles, whichever is the latter. In the event of a tie (equal number of points accumulated), placings will be decided by the player with the higher ranking on The 2010 European Tour Race to Dubai as of August 29, 2010, or at the conclusion of the Johnnie Walker Championship at Gleneagles, whichever is the latter.

(c) The Captain, Colin Montgomerie, will choose the remaining three players on Sunday August 29 following the conclusion of the Johnnie Walker Championship at Gleneagles.

(1) The Ryder Cup World Points List is comprised of World Ranking Points won by a European Tour Member from each tournament in which he participates between September 3, 2009 and August 22, 2010 and thereafter in the 2010 Johnnie Walker Championship at Gleneagles. World Ranking Points are allocated to all officially sanctioned tournaments (on any Federated Tour) by the Official World Golf Ranking and are allocated according to the Event Rating of the tournament.

(2) The Ryder Cup European Points List is comprised of points (1 point = 1 Euro) earned by a European Tour Member from all officially sanctioned European Tour tournaments on The European Tour Race to Dubai between September 3, 2009 and August 29, 2010 or the conclusion of the Johnnie Walker Championship at Gleneagles, whichever is the latter.

Torrance and Woosnam set for Brunei battle

The 2010 European Senior Tour campaign resumes this week when Sam Torrance and Ian Woosnam, last season's Order of Merit top two, go head-to-head in The Aberdeen Brunei Senior Masters presented by The Stapleford Forum.

Torrance returns to Brunei's spectacular Empire Hotel and Country Club, where his tied sixth place finish in the inaugural event last year launched a fine season which culminated in the Scot lifting his third John Jacobs Trophy.

The 2002 Ryder Cup Captain began his defence of that crown with a share of third place in the season curtain-raiser in Mauritius, and will be eager to carry forward his form into the second event on the 2010 schedule.

"I feel like I'm playing well at the moment and I'm confident every time I go out on the course so hopefully that will continue in Brunei," said the 56 year old. "Last year I finished tied sixth after winning the final event of the 2008 season so that really set me up for the good year I went on to have.

"I've already started this season well in Mauritius, so I'm keen to keep it going in Brunei and I'd love to get another win under my belt."

Former World Number One Woosnam is making his maiden appearance in The Aberdeen Brunei Senior Masters presented by The Stapleford Forum, and returns to action for the first time in the 2010 season having missed out on last year's Order of Merit top spot by just €3,380.

The Welshman, who captured the John Jacobs Trophy in his rookie season in 2008, will be hoping for a belated present after he celebrates his 52nd birthday on Tuesday (March 2).

He is joined in the field by fellow former Masters Champion Sandy Lyle, who returns to the Senior Tour fold for the first time since last year's Senior Open Championship presented by MasterCard, where he finished tied 13th. Scotsman Lyle recorded his best Senior Tour finish in this event last year, sharing sixth place with Torrance and England's Glenn Ralph.

American Mike Cuning defends the title he won on his SeniorTour debut last year, when he finished two shots clear of Northern Ireland's Jimmy Heggarty.

Cuning, who won the 1997 Asian Tour Order of Merit, put his knowledge of Asia to good effect – having played in the Brunei Open since 2006 – to become the first player since Denis Watson in the 2007 US Senior PGA Championship to win on his Senior Tour debut, a feat subsequently matched by Mike Allen in the 2009 US Senior PGA Championship.

"Winning in Brunei was huge for me," said Cuning. "Everything had been leading up to turning 50, and then to win on my debut was fantastic. It couldn't have happened at a better time, with me not having any Tour to play on."

England's Kevin Spurgeon heads to

Brunei as the Order of Merit leader, having captured his maiden Senior Tour title in The Mauritius Commercial Bank Open before Christmas.

Spurgeon staged a brave final round fightback at Constance Belle Mare Plage to win by one stroke from former Ryder Cup player Gordon J Brand, who is also in the field this week.

Australian Mike Harwood, a five time winner on The European Tour, returns to action for the first time since winning the OKI Castellon Senior Tour Championship to secure the Rookie of the Year Award.

The 2010 Aberdeen Brunei Senior Masters presented by The Stapleford Forum is once again promoted by WSM Sponsorship and will be played over the 6840 yard, par 71 Jack Nicklaus-designed course at The Empire Hotel and Country Club.
