



Travelling to Turnberry Golf Course:

By car

Lands of Turnberry is easily accessible thanks to recent upgrades to the M77, it is now only one hour's drive from the centre of Glasgow.

From centre of Glasgow

80km/50 miles

Driving time: approximately 1 hour

- Take the M77/A77 southbound from Glasgow signposted to Kilmarnock
- Continue on the A77 southbound through the outskirts of Ayr
- Follow the A77 southbound through Minishant, Maybole and then follow event signage.

From the south

128km/80 miles

Driving time: approximately 2 hours

- Take the M6 to Carlisle (junction 44)
- At Carlisle continue northbound on the A74 (M) to junction 12
- Take the A70 westbound towards Cumnock and Ayr
- On the outskirts of Ayr, take the A77 southbound towards Girvan and Stranraer
- Continue on the A77 through Minishant, Maybole and then follow event signage.

From Glasgow Prestwick Airport

32km/20 miles

Driving time: approximately 30 minutes

- Turn right out of the airport complex
- Join the A78 following signs for the A77 to Glasgow and Stranraer
- Take the A77 southbound signposted to Ayr and Stranraer
- Follow the A77 southbound through Minishant, Maybole and then follow event signage.

From Glasgow Airport

88km/55 miles

Driving time: approximately 55 minutes

- Join the M8 motorway eastbound towards Glasgow city centre and Edinburgh
- Exit the M8 at junction 24

- Follow signs for the M77/A77 towards Prestwick Airport and Kilmarnock
- Follow directions from Glasgow city centre as described above

From Edinburgh Airport

152km/95 miles

Driving time: approximately 2 hours

- Take the M8 motorway westbound through Glasgow until you see signs for the M77
- Take the M77/A77 southbound signposted to Kilmarnock and Prestwick Airport
- Follow the directions from Glasgow city centre as described above.

By air

Both Glasgow International Airport and Glasgow Prestwick Airport are within a one hour's drive from Lands of Turnberry. Glasgow airport is host to over over 40 airlines serving approximately 80 cities worldwide. Glasgow Prestwick Airport offers flights to and from over 25 European cities. Scotland's second biggest airport Edinburgh International is a two hours' drive away.

By rail

Trains run frequently from Glasgow Central Station to Ayr railway station which is just 20 minutes from Turnberry Golf Course. Girvan station is just 10 minutes away from the course with trains running direct from Ayr railway station. A Courtesy Shuttle will be in operation from Girvan station to the Golf Course. Times are still TBC.

By Ferry

There are three ferry terminals within an hour's drive of Lands of Turnberry: Stranraer and Cairnryan to the south and Troon to the north.

Cairnryan and Troon terminals are accessible from Larne, Northern Ireland while Stranraer ferry departs from Belfast, Northern Ireland.

Car Parking onsite:

There is free public parking onsite at Turnberry Golf Course. If you purchase your admission ticket in advance you will be sent a parking pass for reserved parking onsite. Event signage will direct you to the public car parks as you near Turnberry. Upon arrival at the car park there is a shuttle bus service running down to the Tented Village.

If you have been issued with a Car Park label please follow the event signage to your designated car park.
